

# SportsDo Tracker Quick Start Guide

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This Guide is intended to quickly enable the user to set up and use the SportsDo Tracker. ## About GPS Tracker

The StarsNav BTS-110 tracker can store up to 4mb of data. This is more than enough for a day's skiing for example. The battery life is around 22 hours so will be enough for most sporting activities and takes around 3 hours to fully charge.

As well as useful for gps tracking, the unit can also be used as a Bluetooth GPS receiver that will work along SportsDo Mobile on your mobile phone to provide you with interactive and live tracking for your activity. ## Tracker set up

For the unit's first use, it will take around 8 hours to fully charge. When charged, switch it on using the centre button. It is important to keep the unit still and under the open sky for it to successfully get a fix on the satellites.

Once the tracker has a fix it will start to flash red which means it is also recording and is ready for use.

The green flashing light on the left means the unit has power and the blue flashing light on the right means that bluetooth is enabled.

To switch the unit off, hold down the centre button until you hear a load screech and the lights will go out.

## Start Up

1. Switch on the tracker as described in the set up section and make sure it is flashing red.
2. Start your activity. You may at this point put the unit in a pocket once it has the satellite fix.

## SportsDo Desktop

To enable you to import your activity tracks from the tracker device onto the SportsDo portal ([www.sportsdo.net](http://www.sportsdo.net)) you will need to install and set up **SportsDo Desktop**.

### Install

SportsDo Desktop can be downloaded to your PC from the following link:

When the File Download Security warning appears, select **Run** to proceed.

### Run SportsDo Desktop

Once SportsDo Desktop is installed, go to: **Start -> All Programs -> SportsDo Desktop**

on your PC to run the software. Check that the status message at the bottom of the screen says "Waiting for 'StarsNav BTS-110' to

be attached” or “Waiting for GPS to be attached”.

## **SportsDo Desktop Set Up**

Click on the **Settings** button on the main screen. This will allow you to define the input device, set up which SportsDo account the uploaded activities belong to and select a default activity type as well as various other settings.

- a. to select an input device, click on the **Change Settings** button underneath Download from device. You can select StarsNav BTS-110, Garmin Serial GPS or Garmin USB GPS.
- b. to select the SportsDo account you wish to upload tracks to, click on the **Change** button underneath Upload to. Give your SportsDo nickname and password. If you haven't already created your account, click **Join** instead to set this up.
- c. to change your **default Activity type** click on the pull down menu.
- d. **Prompt before downloading data** - allows you to be prompted before data is downloaded from your device rather than the default automatically.
- e. **Manual Upload to SportsDo Portal** - if checked will require you to manually upload the activity tracks via the upload button on the main screen.
- f. **Clear device after successful upload** - will automatically erase the contents of your GPS unit once the tracks have been successfully uploaded.

- g. **Automatically split tracks into sessions** - will allow SportsDo to split one large track into smaller sessions based on a specified gap time.

Select **OK** once your settings are complete.

## **Importing an Activity**

To import an activity from your GPS device into SportsDo you must first connect the device to your PC via the USB or Serial cable.

SportsDo Desktop should be able to see your device before it can begin to import its data.

To import the data:

**Select -> Import**

## **Uploading an activity**

Upload an imported activity to the SportsDo web site ([www.sportsdo.net](http://www.sportsdo.net)) . To upload an individual track or all tracks listed:

**Select -> Upload or Upload All**

## **Viewing an activity**

You can view a selected activity by highlighting the required activity and

**Select -> View**

This will display the activity page in a browser window.

## **Deleting an activity**

Delete an existing activity from the SportsDo Desktop screen, select the activity from the activity list and

**Select -> Delete**

This will only delete the activity from the local SportsDo Desktop screen and NOT from the SportsDo portal.
